
YWCP first day of school is Wednesday, September 8th.

COVID Safety: We are closely following developments related to COVID-19 guidance, infection rates, and more. ***We are committed to a full return for all students, five days per week.*** At this time, we are not planning any remote options. We will of course be prepared to “go remote” if circumstances change, but at this point, we expect a return to what looks like a relatively normal year. We believe the greatest success against COVID -19 infection is to be vaccinated. Vaccination reduces the risk of serious illness or hospitalization. Any person 12 years old and over can be vaccinated at their nearest pharmacy or you can contact your primary physician for more information.

Transportation: If you are in need of information in regards to transportation or if you are unsure transportation has been set up, you must contact your home district's transportation department. Rochester City School District Transportation Department Phone Number is 585.336.4000.

Uniform Policy: We will be adhering to the YWCP Uniform Policy beginning the first day of school, September 8th. All students must wear the appropriate uniform. Please reach out to your child's counselor if you have any questions or concerns in regards to this policy. See attached uniform information form to order any new items for uniforms.

Cell Phone Policy: Cellular phones and the use of other electronic devices are not permitted at school. YWCP staff, however, recognizes the need for students to have cell phones to and from school for safety and security reasons. If parents desire students to bring electronic devices to school, please be aware that YWCP will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items. All electronic devices that are brought to school will be turned in to the appropriate staff member at the beginning of each day. Devices will be tagged and stored in a secure location during the school day and will be returned to students at the end of the school day. Please understand that students who violate the YWCP Cell Phone/Electronic Devices Policy will have their devices confiscated and face possible consequences. Confiscated cell phones/devices will only be returned to a parent or guardian who retrieves the item(s) in person during regular school hours.
