Low Risk Symptoms

Headache
Body Aches
Runny Nose/Congestion
Nausea/Vomiting
Diarrhea
Swelling or Redness of Hands/Feet
Rash

High Risk Symptoms

Fever (100.0)
New Cough
Shortness of breath
Loss of taste/smell
Chills
Sore Throat

In accordance with the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Department of Health, and NYS Department of Education guidelines, the following must be followed for return to school:

1. If a swab for COVID-19 is done and the result is positive:

The parent/guardian will notify the school as soon as possible and will follow CDC guidelines before returning to school. The School Nurse will be in contact with the Department of Health for further instructions.

2. If the student was seen by a provider and no test was done, however an alternative diagnosis was made:

The student may return to school with the provider's note and afebrile (fever free) for 24 hours without medication and improved symptoms.

3. If a swab for COVID-19 is done and the result is negative:

The student must produce proof of negative PCR test (from provider or copy of test results) and be fever free for 24 hours without medication and improved symptoms.

4. If the student was not tested for COVID-19 and did not see a provider:

The child may return to school after 10 days have passed since symptoms, 72 hours fever free without medication, and symptoms have improved.

Most people have mild illnesses and are able to recover at home. If any of the following symptoms develop, call 911 for immediate assistance:

- Trouble breathing
- New Confusion
- Bluish lips or face
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- Inability to wake up or stay awake
